



## **Use of Chemicals for Rodent and Weed Control**

Past experiences have shown that the risk of polyethylene film becoming brittle is increased when exposed to elemental sulfur and other chemical types. The risk of splitting and tearing is also increased - particularly when the bag is under stress from being filled - due to the polyethylene film becoming brittle.

AT Films Inc. recommends that ideal storage sites should be comprised of either a sand/gravel base, concrete or asphalt. Control of weeds and long grasses should be accomplished through mechanical means (mowers, weed eaters, etc.), or by using the approved chemical Round Up® (manufactured by Monsanto). The site should also be free of garbage or other nuisance piles.
